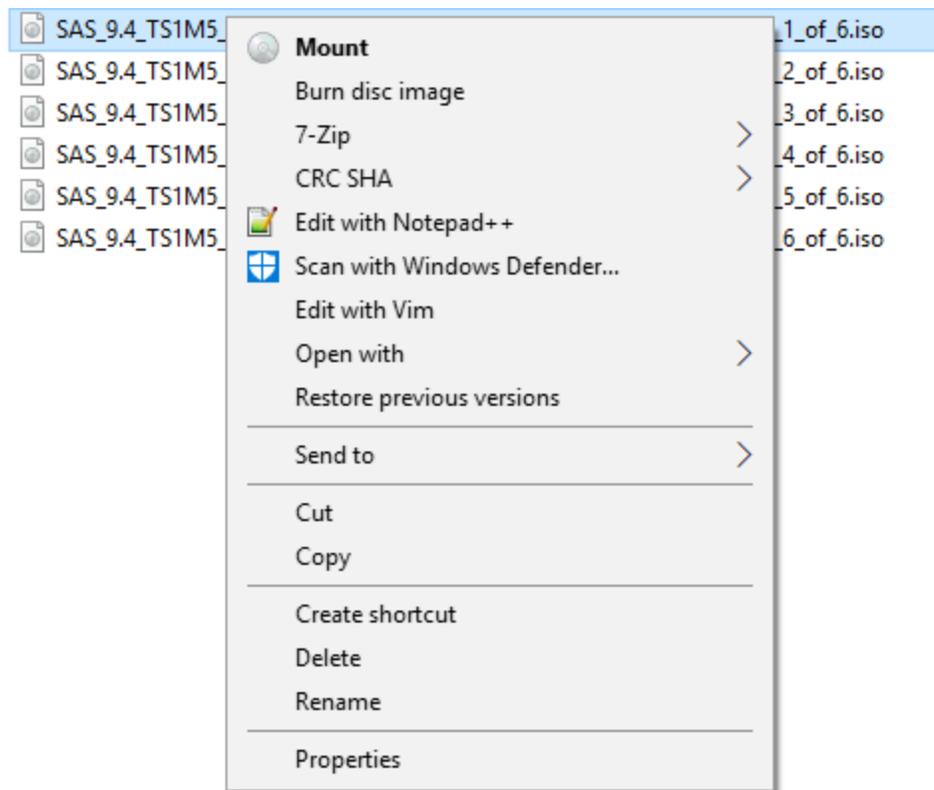


ISO Mounting Instructions

With Windows 8.1 and above the operating system can mount ISO files using the instructions below. This will make the ISO act as a virtual DVD drive and create a drive letter such as E:\.

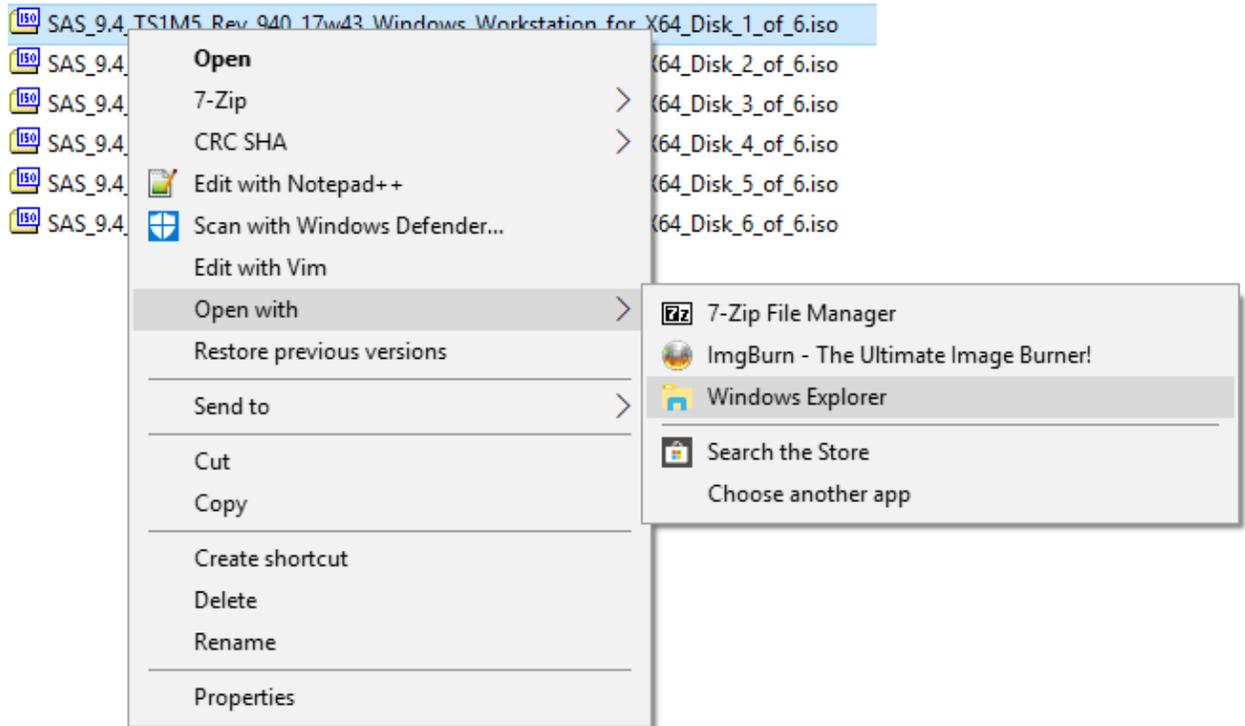
For Windows Vista and Windows 7 please see the next section titled **ISO Extraction Instructions**.

- 1) Navigate to the location where you have saved the ISO file.
- 2) Right-click on the ISO file and then select **Mount** option mount it.



Note: If you do not see the option Mount then the .ISO file type is likely associated with another program.

Navigate to the **Open with** and Select **Windows Explorer**.



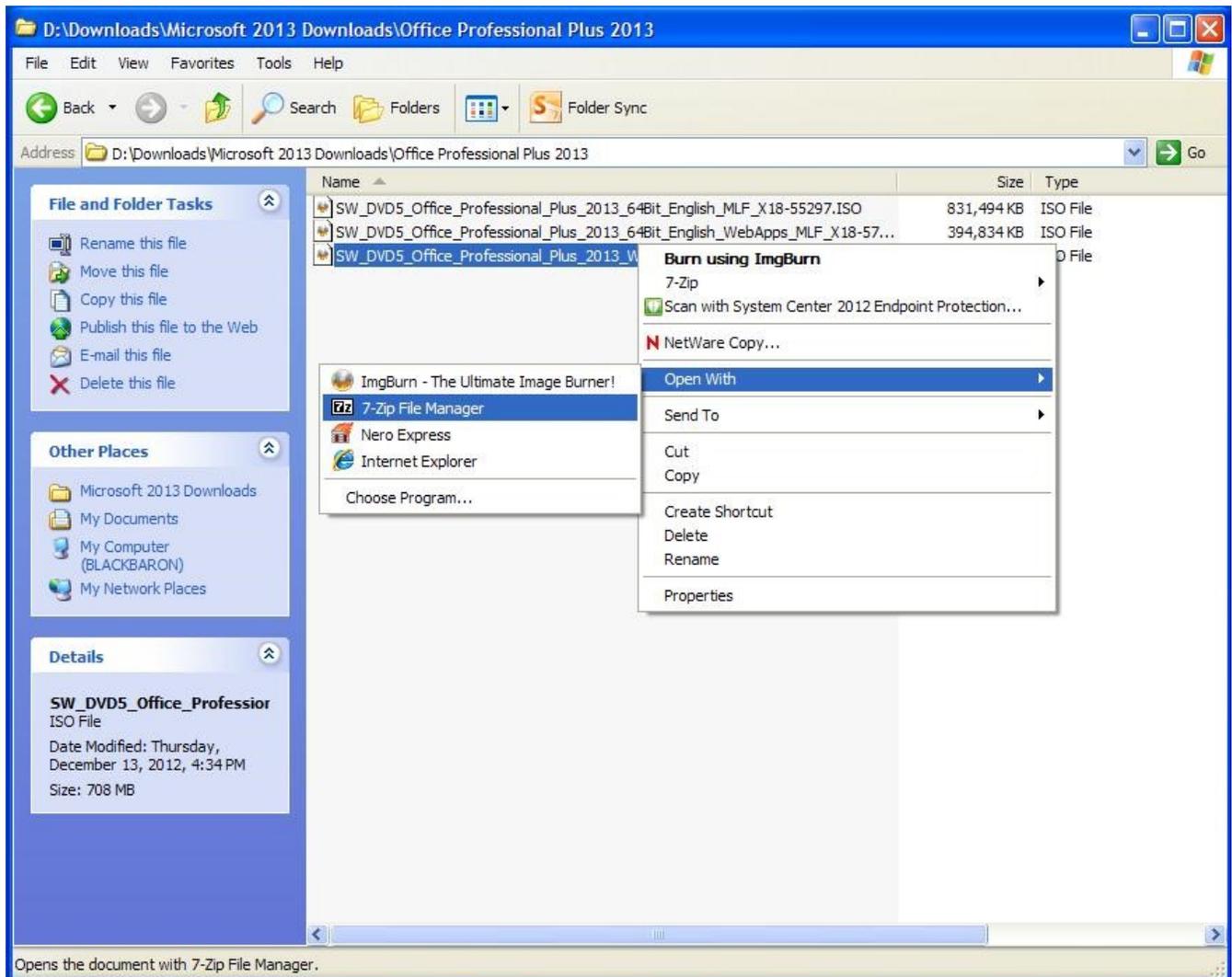
- 3) You should now see a new window with the contents of the mounted ISO file. If not, double-click on the new virtual drive in This PC (Computer/My Computer) to access ISO file contents.
- 4) To unmount, right-click on the virtual drive in This PC (Computer/My Computer) and then select Eject option.

ISO Extraction Instructions

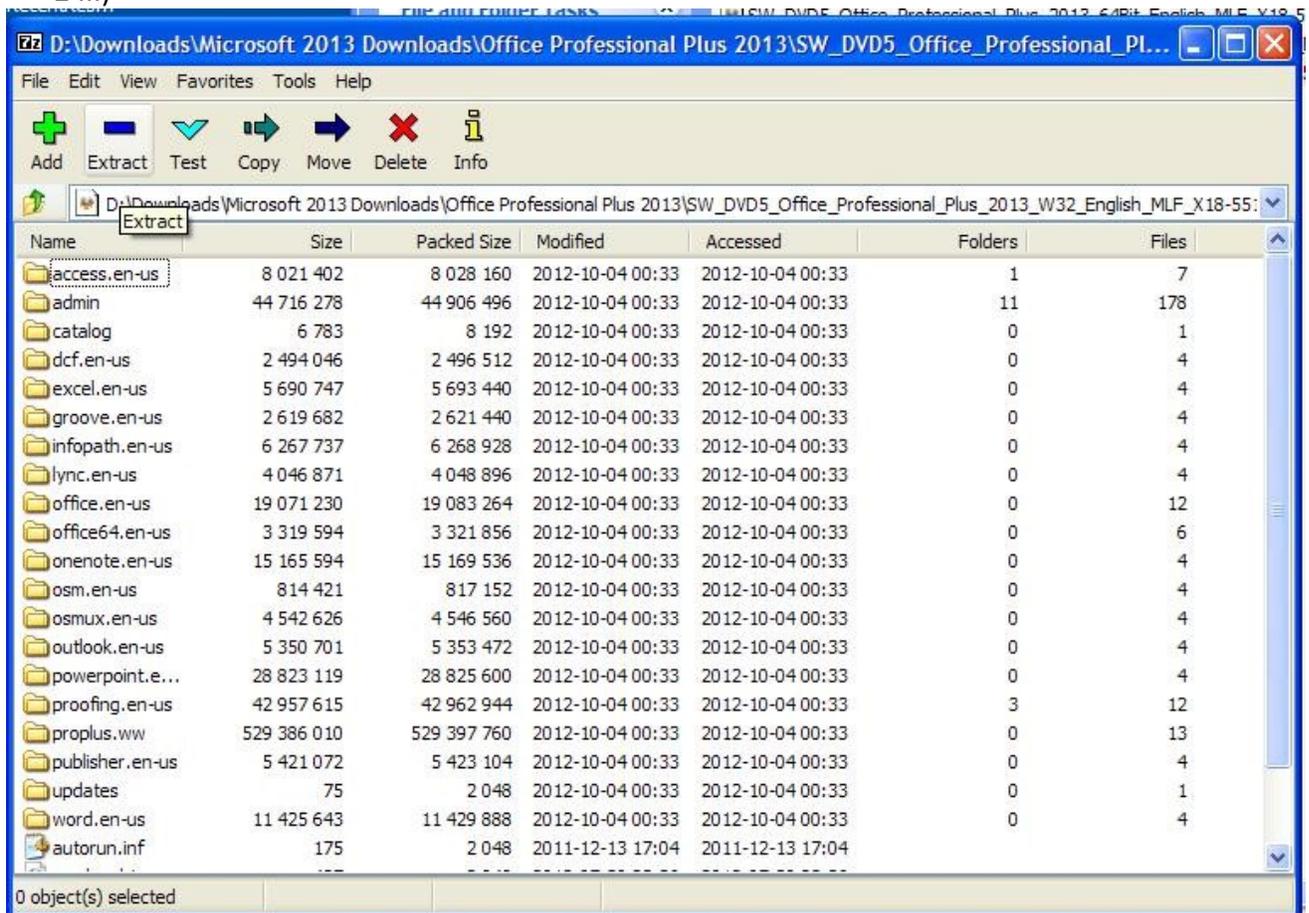
1) Download 7-Zip. It is available for free from the following website:

<http://www.7-zip.org/>

2) **Right click** on the file you have downloaded and choose **Open with - 7 Zip File Manager**. A new window will open, which lists all the contents of your ISO file (that you have downloaded).



- 3) Click **Extract**. (Note: Each disk needs to be extracted to a separate folder such as Disk 1, Disk 2 ...)



- 4) All the contents from the file will be extracted. After the extraction is complete, you can double click **set-up.exe**, to start installing the software in your computer.
